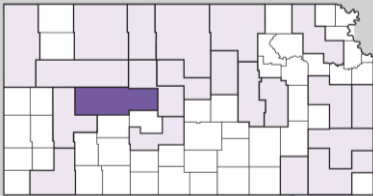

Walnut Creek Extension District is comprised of Rush, Ness, and Lane Counties, in west central Kansas. When fully staffed, the district consists of four agents, three office professionals, and three 4-H program assistants. The district has a combined population of approximately 7,280, with 15 rural communities and 6 school districts.

POSITION DESCRIPTION AND RESPONSIBILITIES

4-H Ambassadors work together with a team of approximately 3-8

Ambassadors and an adult advisor to develop a public information program for the county/district 4-H Program.

- Provide volunteer lead leadership for educational programming related to agriculture and natural resources.
- Share responsibility for the 4-H youth development programming related to Agriculture and Natural Resources.
- Share responsibility for community vitality programming that helps our communities become better places to live, work, and play. Programming will strengthen social, civic, economic, and technological capacity of communities through leadership development and civic engagement.
- Ambassador Work will include these steps:
 - Writing articles of educational information for Ag and Natural Resources 4-H Projects
 - Promoting 4-H Ag projects through radio and television
 - Serving as a Junior Leaders to a 4-H Ag Project
 - Participating in the CRI part of Club Days as an individual.
 - Assisting with School enrichment or Daycamp programming
 - Working on Ag & Natural Resources Community Service projects.

Attend a state Training of Ambassador

Assist in creating Promotional pieces for 4-H Ag

Assist with Daycamps throughout the District

Present at least one public presentation on any Ag topic

Be a Junior Leader for an Ag related 4-H Project
